### Conversation Four

*[people meeting at a party]*

F: I'm sorry. I don't know your name.  
M: It's Andreas.  
F: Sorry?  
M: Andreas. And **you** are?  
F: Susan, Susan Jones.  
M: Lovely to meet you, Susan.

*(Wait 10 seconds before repeating.)*

*(Wait 10 seconds before going onto the next conversation.)*

Now, look at the question for Conversation Five. *(10 seconds.)*

### Conversation Five

- F: This is **great**, isn't it?
- M: I know; I **love** being warm all day.
- F: And it never rains **here** in June.
- M: Not like at **home**.
- F: Shame we can't stay longer!

*(Wait 10 seconds before repeating.)*

*(10 seconds.)*

*(Wait 10 seconds before going onto the next conversation.)*

Now, look at the question for Conversation Six. *(10 seconds.)*

### Conversation Six

- F: Can I help you?
- M: Yes, can I try these in a size forty-two, please?
- F: Here you are. *[slight pause]*
- M: Oh no! They hurt my feet. Too tight.
- F: *[slight pause]* What about these?
- M: Mmm. They're comfortable.

*(Wait 10 seconds before repeating.)*

*(10 seconds.)*

**Listening part four.**

You will hear a conversation. You will hear the conversation twice. Choose the correct answers.  
(10 seconds.)

- F: So you and your wife want a computer course?
- M: That's right.
- F: Can you use a computer?
- M: I'm afraid not.
- F: The beginners' class then. Anything in particular you want to do: send emails, write letters, use the internet, play music... ?
- M: Use the Internet.
- F: Those classes are on Tuesday or Friday.
- M: Tuesday, please.
- F: The evening's full, but you can come in the morning or afternoon.
- M: Afternoon then, please.
- F: There're two groups: from one to three, or from three to five pm.
- M: Three to five, please.
- F: And you want **two** places?
- M: That's right. How much is it?
- F: Well, usually the course costs fifty pounds, but because you're both 65, it's free.
