Now, look at the question for Conversation Four. *(10 seconds.)*

Conversation Four

- M: Excuse me, where's the travel section please?
- F: Do you want books about a particular country?
- M: Yes, India. I'm going there on business.
- F: The Asian travel guides are over there.

(Wait 10 seconds before repeating.)

(Wait 10 seconds before going onto the next conversation.)

Now, look at the question for Conversation Five. *(10 seconds.)*

Conversation Five

F: Does the fifty-two go to the shopping centre?

M: Yes, it does but it only runs on weekdays.

F: Which buses run at weekends?

M: Numbers fifty-six and fifty-seven.

F: How often do they run?

M: Every twenty minutes.

(Wait 10 seconds before repeating.)

(Wait 10 seconds before going onto the next conversation.)

Now, look at the question for Conversation Six. *(10 seconds.)*

Conversation Six

M: How nice to see you.

F: Yes, it's good to see you too.

M: What are you doing tomorrow? Do you want to go out?

F: I'm afraid I can't tomorrow. I'm very busy.

M: Oh, perhaps another time.

F: Yes, perhaps.

(Wait 10 seconds before repeating.)

(10 seconds.)

Listening part four.
